FAQ'S REENACTORS

1. Will water and firewood be provided?  
Yes, firewood will be in stock piles throughout the encampments, water is accessible at the Volz building and a water buffalo will be located next to band shell. Free lemonade will be served to all reenactors in the beer tent throughout the weekend.
2. What Hotel do you recommend?  
The Hampton Inn located at 3555 Mall Loop Drive in Joliet will have special discounts for reenactors during World War II Days. (815 439-9500)
3. Are there any restaurants near Dellwood Park?  
A list of restaurants will be provided at registration. The most convenient eatery to Dellwood Park is Sizzles located 571 East 13<sup>th</sup> St., Lockport Il. (815 524-4391)
4. Are there any vendors selling ammo?  
Yes, this year Atlantic Wall will be present and will be selling ammo 330-936-6675. Pre-order and save on shipping.
5. What about safety of reenactors?  
Although not a sanctioned HRS event, their safety rules do apply. We ask all reenactors to bring their ammo in a clear plastic bag to be inspected at the safety and authenticity check each morning at 8:30a.m. Plastic bags will be provided at registration.
6. What is the exact address of Dellwood Park to use for my GPS.

7. When can I arrive and where do I park?  
You can arrive no earlier than Thursday before noon. No cars are allowed in encampments after 8:30 a.m. each morning. Reenactor parking is free and will be marked with signage when you arrive. You may drive to unload your equipment at your camp site.
