

COVID-19 Safety Procedures and Guidelines

General Health

- The wearing of masks is currently optional.
- Handwashing/Sanitizing will be encouraged throughout the day.
- If you are sick, please do not enter our facilities. Contact and follow the advice of your medical provider.

Health Monitoring

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. Anyone can have mild to severe symptoms.

Possible symptoms include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
