FAQ'S REENACTORS

1. Will water and firewood be provided?  
Yes, firewood will be in stock piles throughout the encampments and water is accessible at the Volz building and a water buffalo will be located near the battlefield.
2. What Hotel do you recommend?

3. Are there any restaurants near Dellwood Park?  
A list of restaurants will be provided at registration.
4. Are there any vendors selling blank ammo?  
No
5. What about safety of reenactors?  
Although not a sanctioned HRS event their safety rules do apply. We ask all reenactors to bring their ammo in a clear plastic bag to be inspected at safety and authenticity on Saturday morning at 8:30 am. Plastic bags and ear plugs will be provided at registration. All crew served weapons including mortars, M.G.'s, and bazookas or panzerfaust will be checked at S & A on Saturday morning. Please bring these items with you on Saturday morning to S&A. The use of homemade pyro will not be allowed at this event. The use of Aerial flares will not be allowed. If you are unsure of the safety guidelines of your impression, please reach out to the respective event organizers with any questions or concerns.
6. What about authenticity?  
Although not an HRS sanctioned event, HRS Authenticity rules will be observed and enforced at this event. This will include haircut standards, facial hair standards and the use of period correct eye wear. Any era that the HRS does not specifically have authenticity rules for, will be at the discretion of the event organizers and personnel.

8. Where do I Park when I arrive and when Can I arrive?  
Reenactor parking is free and will be marked with signage when you arrive. You may drive to unload your equipment at your camp site. No cars are allowed in encampments after 8:30 am each morning. You can arrive no earlier than Thursday before noon.

12. Are unit campsites assigned? Yes, Camp locations are assigned based on the number of reenactors using the site, number of tents, size of tents and if space is required to park vehicles or special displays. Camp locations will be designated with a sign indicating the units' designated camp location.
  
13. Will food be provided to reenactors?  
Yes, A café will be set up in the Volz building serving breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday from 7 am – 4 pm. Please bring your own utensils.
14. Although not an HRS sanctioned event, HRS authenticity rules will be observed and enforced at this event, this will include haircut standards, facial hair standards and the use of period correct eye wear.
15. Where do I check in when I arrive?  
Registration and check in is at Volz Building. Registration hours are Friday 5 – 9 pm, Saturday 7 – 10 am, Sunday 8-9 am. All actors need to check in and sign the waiver form.
