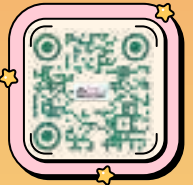

LTPD Welcomes New Executive Director



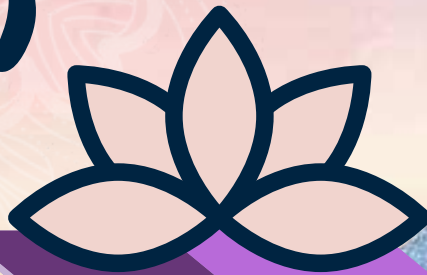

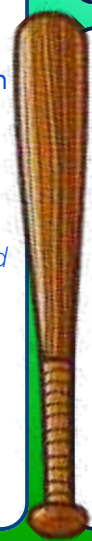
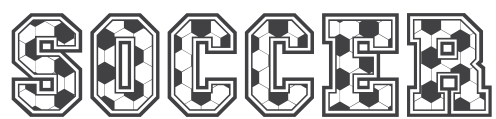
Fall Soccer Leagues
